German-Polish Youth Office

Subvention for trilateral projects with participants from Germany, France and Poland

Trilateral programmes with participants from Germany, France and Poland can be subsidized by both the Franco-German Youth Office (DFJW/OFAJ) and the German-Polish Youth Office (DPJW/ PNWM). The total amount of both subsidies shall, however, not exceed the real costs of the project.

For subsidies, the DFJW and the DPJW decided the following:

Projects in France and Germany

The DFJW/ OFAJ subsidizes according to its funding conditions for trilateral projects. Accordingly, the request for subsidy can be submitted by the German or French but not by the Polish carrier. The DFJW subsidizes in this framework also the travel costs for the Polish participants, from and to the place of departure in Poland. These costs will be indicated by the corresponding French or German carrier at the time of application.

Projects in Poland

The DFJW subsidizes travel costs for German and French participants to the meeting place in Poland. The according application can be submitted by the French or German but not by the Polish carrier.

The DPJW subsidizes programme costs of projects in Poland, according to the funding conditions. The according application can be jointly submitted by the German and Polish carrier.

Content Subsidies

Both Youth Offices also support youth exchange through training seminars for the carriers, info material about the organisation, methods and topics concerning youth exchanges.
